Stall Fees

Stall fees are as follows:

Standard Site (3mx3m)	\$165.00
Double Site (6mx3m)	\$220.00
Extra Large Site (maximum 60m²)	\$385.00
Access and use of electricity (1 day)	\$ 11.00
Access and use of electricity (2 days)	\$ 22.00
Camping (included in the fee)	FREE

^{*}Complimentary Rally passes will be provided for yourself and staff for the duration of the event.

Stall Trading Hours

Stall trading hours are from Friday 12pm to 5pm and Saturday 8.30am to 5pm.

The above fees are flat rates for the two days trading, you may choose to attend just one day (fees are the same). You are obliged to stay set up until 5pm each trading day, unless arranged with site manager.

Food Vendors Hours

Food vendors trading hours are from **Friday 12pm to 10pm and Saturday 12pm to 10pm.** (you are required to be set up before 12pm and are obliged to stay set up until food service is no longer required or arranged with site manager).

Payment Details

Full payment of fees should accompany the application form.

Cancellations

If the stall holder wishes to cancel the booking after the 1st November, the committee will retain the full registration fee. If the stallholder wishes to cancel prior to the 1st November, due to unforeseen circumstances, then a full refund will be provided.

Electricity

Please indicate on your application form if you will require electricity to your stall (10amp/15amp), and the number of power points required. Stall holders are asked to supply all required extension leads and adapters to connect to the power supply. It is recommended that leads be at least 30m long. Leads must be tested and tagged prior to use.

Insurance

Public liability insurance cover is compulsory for all stall holders. Please forward a copy of your public liability insurance policy with your registration form and payment.

Food Vendors

It is compulsory for all food stalls to provide a copy of Safe Food Handlining Certificate or equivalent with your registration form and payment.

Liability

The Walcha Motorcycle Rally Committee accepts no responsibility for damage arising to stallholders produce and equipment from theft, breakages, storms, and/or electrical failure. Stall holders participate in the Walcha Motorcycle Rally at their own risk.

Site Manager

There will be a site manager onsite for the duration of the Walcha Motorcycle Rally. If you have any concerns please contact the site manager. If the site manager deems that an appropriate level of public safety has not been met then your stall will not be permitted to trade.

Security

Security will be onsite for the duration of the Walcha Motorcycle Rally. Stall holders are responsible for their own produce, stock and equipment on site and security will not be responsible for any losses or damage. Stall holders are encouraged to secure their site and remove any valuables at the end of trading on each day.

Weather Conditions

Please ensure that you have a wet weather contingency plan for your stall and your stock.
